

Assigning Problems Using ASSISTments Direct

If you do not have an ASSISTments account or do not want to make ASSISTments accounts for your students, you can use the ASSISTments Direct platform. This step-by-step tutorial will show you how to assign a problem set to your class and view the reports without having to make an ASSISTments account for you or your students.

What you'll need:

- the “share link” to the problem set you want to assign
- a Google account, Google Classroom, or an e-mail address

Instructions

1. Click the share link that was given to you by the person who built the assignment you want to assign. It should look something like this:

2. You have one of three options to choose for how you want to assign these assignments. Have the links emailed to you, have the links emailed to you and added to your new or existing ASSISTment Direct account, or share in Google Classroom
 - a. If you do not want to sign up for an ASSISTments Direct account, select the first option E-mail me my links. This will send you two links, one for the students to complete the assignment and another link so that you can view the report.

- b. If you want to sign up for an ASSISTments Direct account, select the second option Login or create an account to get my links. If you do not have an ASSISTments Direct account, you can use a standard email address, Google account, or Facebook account to create an account. This will add the assignment to your account and send you two links, one for the students to complete the assignment and another link so that you can view the report.
- c. If you want to share this assignment in your Google Classroom, select the third option Share to Google Classroom. It will ask you to log in to your Google account and request permission. Follow the instructions on the screen to complete the assignment process.



3. Once you have successfully accessed your ASSISTments Direct account, you will see the assignments listed on the page.
 - a. Clicking on View under Share Link will display the URL used in Step 1.

 - b. Clicking on View under Direct Links will display the two URLs for student and teacher access.
